

ACM2012 Press Registration

1. Registration

Press registration for the conference is complimentary and allows access to all oral and poster sessions.

Press registration does not include the following:

- lunches and coffee breaks
- access to the reception and banquet
- access to the conference excursion

On arrival at the conference venue, please proceed to the 2F registration desk to pick up your press pass. The press pass must be worn at all times within the venue.

Please let us know if you would like to participate in any portion of the conference that is not included in the press registration. In this case, we will ask you to cover any fees applying.

2. Press Coverage

In general, press are permitted to freely cover any portion of the oral and poster program in a manner that does not interfere with the presentation, discussion and surrounding attendees.

- photos

Photos are permitted with the exception of flash photography during oral sessions.

- Video recording

Recording of video images without sound or use of flash is permitted.

- Audio recording

Audio recording of session content is not permitted under any conditions. Audio recording of private interviews should be done with the permission of the interviewee.

- Interviews

Interviews are permitted under the condition that they do not interfere with presentation, discussion and surrounding attendees.

Interview space (closed room) is provided on the 3F of the conference venue. It is recommended that press use this space for interviews.

Requests for interview candidates on specific research topics can be fielded by the Local Organizing Committee (LOC).

3. Media Reporting

The LOC places no restrictions on the media in which ACM2012 press coverage is reported, however coverage that refers to individual research should be done with the consent of the author. Please provide a link or copy of any reporting on the conference to the LOC as noted below. In the case of a private interview, we would appreciate it if you provide a copy of the media clipping to the interviewee also.
